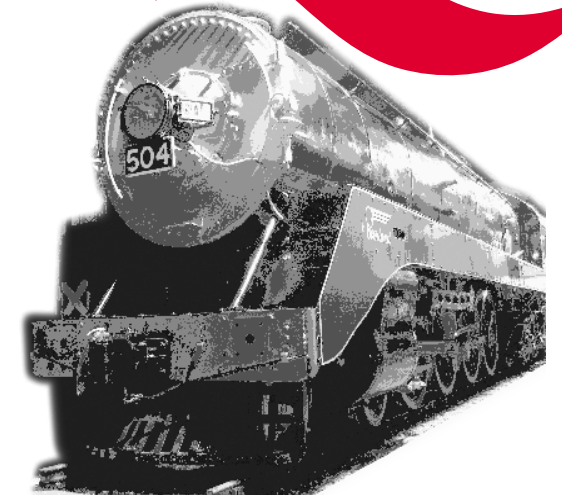

Membership benefits

The National Railway Museum is a not-for-profit, self-funded museum maintained and run by a dedicated group of volunteers and two employees.

As well as the satisfaction of knowing that you are contributing financially to the museum, all members are entitled to:

- Free unlimited entry to the National Railway Museum during normal opening hours, 10am to 5pm.
- Family and Gold members receive a free pass for 2 Family return trips on the Semaphore and Fort Glanville Tourist Railway on membership renewal.
- Single members receive a free pass for 1 Family return trip on the Semaphore and Fort Glanville Tourist Railway on membership renewal.
- 10% discount on most purchases in the Break of Gauge Shop.
- Six issues of Catch Point magazine per year, Catch Point contains photographs and railway happenings around the state and up-to-date information on the Museum and the SteamRanger Heritage Railway.
- 10% Discount on Cafeteria Car party hire.
- Gold members also receive four free adult admission passes to give to family or friends.
- Junior members have no voting rights and are not eligible to nominate for the Board.
- NRM members receive a 5% discount on purchases from End of the Line Hobbies, either from the Victor Harbor shop or at railway exhibitions and railway swap meets or by using the mail order service. Please ensure you present your current NRM membership card each time you make a purchase from End of the Line Hobbies or provide the card details when using the mail order service. This arrangement applies until end of November 2016.

Members and friends are most welcome to attend General Meetings, held at 7.30pm on the fourth Friday of every odd month - location as notified in the Catchpoint magazine.

All members (limited to one per family) have full voting rights on issues pertaining to the museum. The business part of the meeting is followed by refreshments and slide or video presentations by members or special guests.

Member Participation

Members are encouraged to become actively involved in key activities including staffing the shop, restoring locomotives and rollingstock, gardening, cataloguing of archives, display development, or by joining general working bees.

Specialised skills are always sought for plumbing, electrical, or carpentry work, conducting, guarding or driving trains, administration and tour guides.

Members and volunteers participating in on-site activities are each required to submit a National Police Certificate, also referred to as a 'police check' to the Chairman or Vice Chairman. These certificates will be treated as 'confidential' and will be returned to the member or volunteer.
